

2017 MÉTISSE MONTBLEAU VINEYARD SAINT HELENA

Our Estate vineyard located adjacent to the winery in the AVA of Saint Helena is a two-acre parcel with vines dating over 30 years. Soils are rich with obsidian and loam which is quite evident in the aromatics of this wine. A deep garnet purple color with black currant, boysenberry, hints of cured meats, gravel and loamy earth. It is a powerful wine with firm, grainy tannins but still maintains its freshness.

Ripe and well balanced, full bodied with a huge finish, this wine will age beautifully.
